PROJECT BRIEF

The project is to design a UX UI for Montclair State University's Degree Works, Audit. My goal is to find out what is the problem with Degree Works, and execute it by doing research.

My research consists of interviews, to figure out what is wrong with Degree works and to run tests to watch my interviewees behaviors and personalities. By doing so I am able to find out problems and then work to fix them by creating a new design that will help and satisfy the needs of my interviewees. With that being stated from the data that I have collected, I developed personas and scenarios to help beta test my design.

My design primarily satisfies the needs and wants of my primary personas, and the given scenarios of that "What if."

In my design, I designed the UX UI to be like a helping person. A person that understands its user's every wants and needs of their significant other. Therefore I developed it to be fully interactive, by allowing the users to proceed with actions, and also initiate those actions with buttons, and scrolling.

PRIMARY PERSONAS

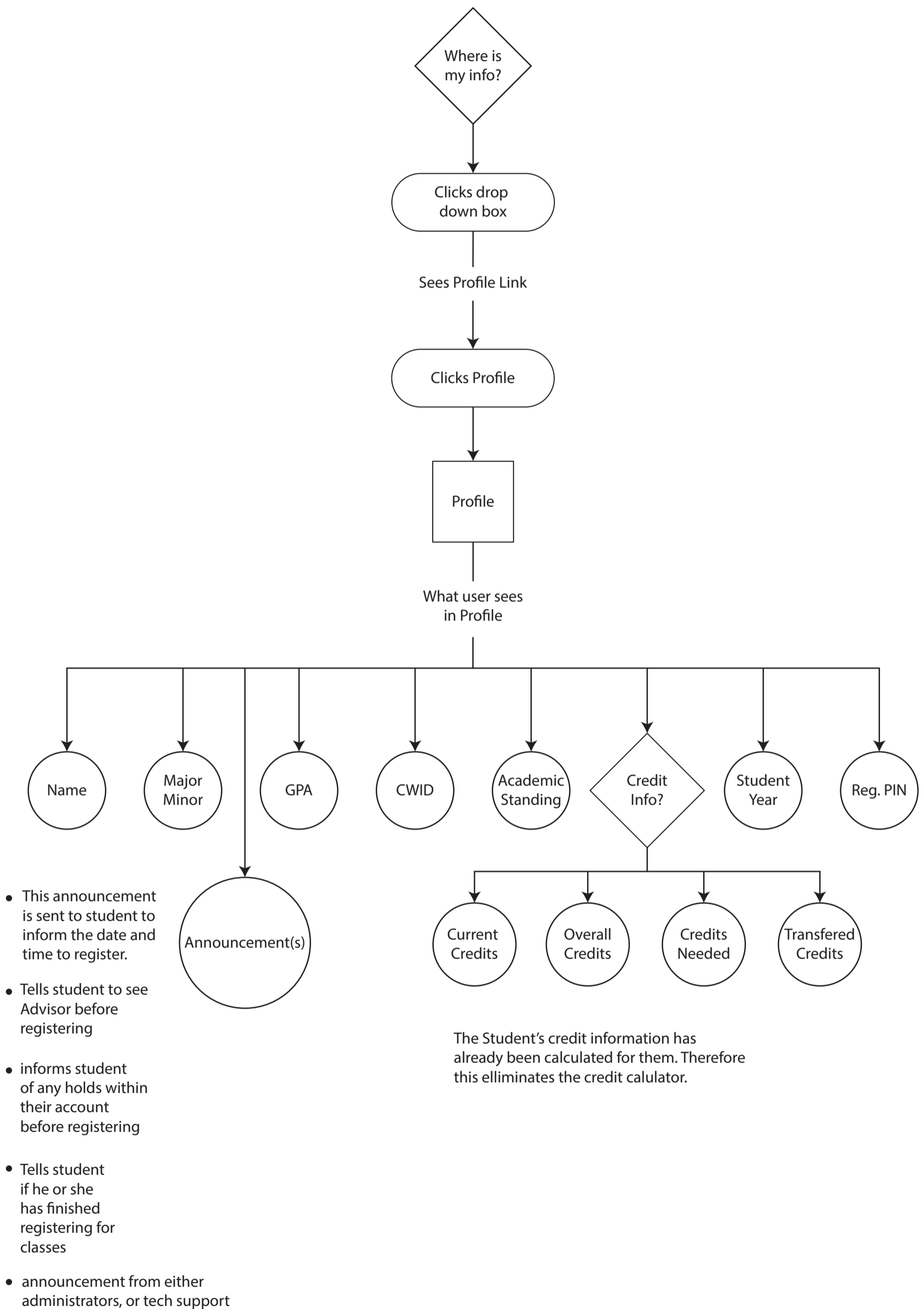
SECONDARY PERSONAS

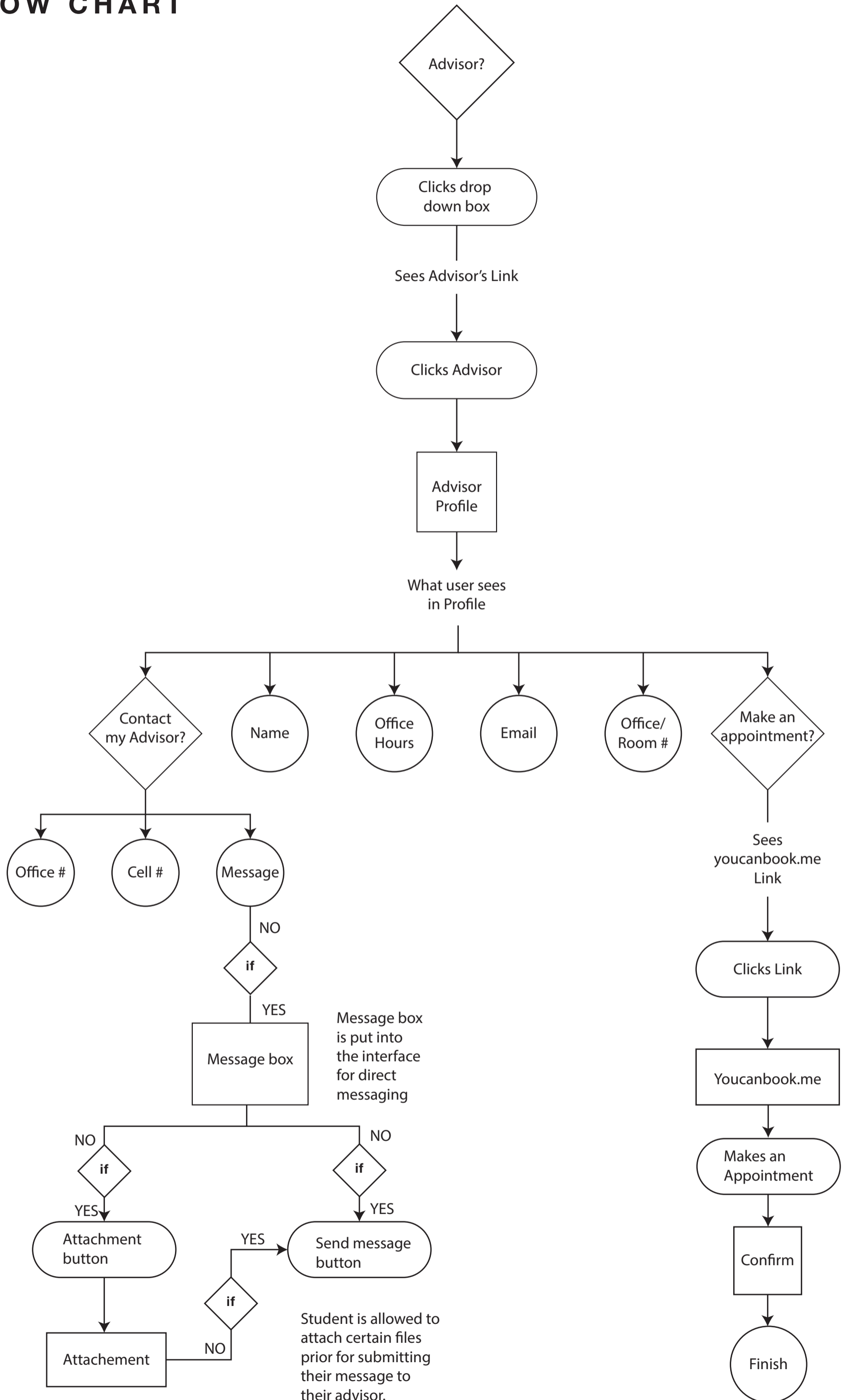
SENARIO 2

USER PROFILE FLOW CHART

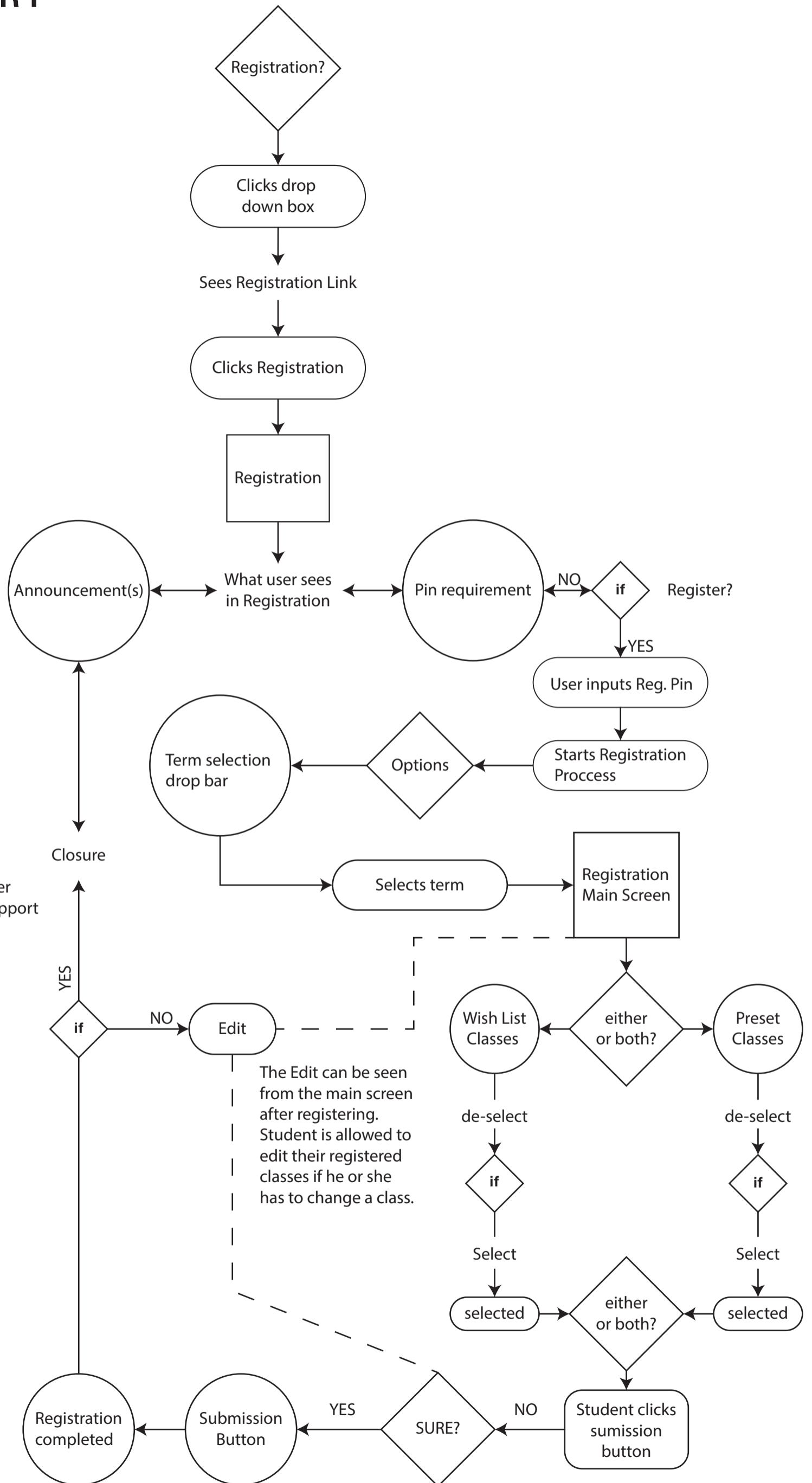


ADVISOR PAGE FLOW CHART



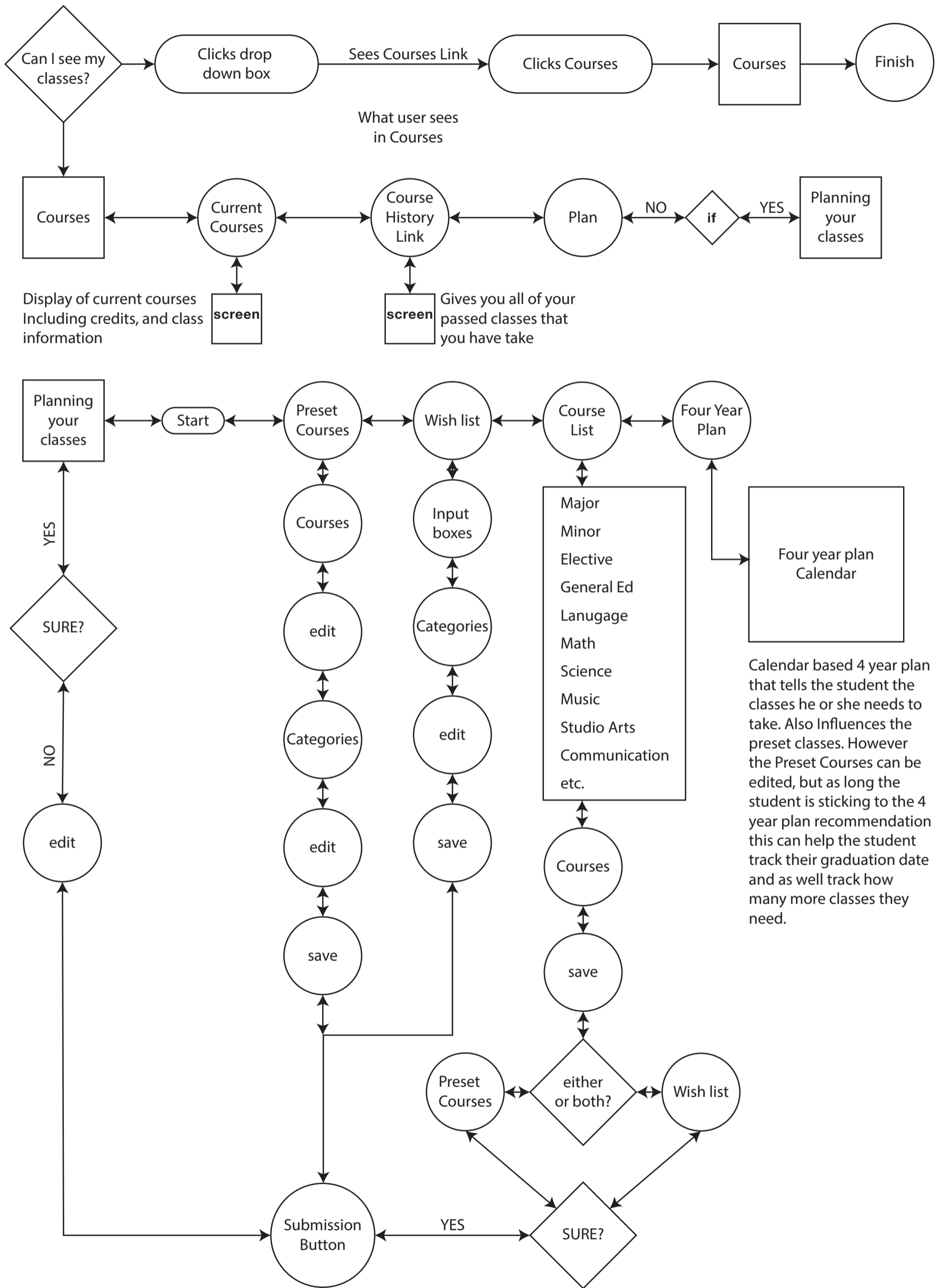
REGISTRATON PAGE FLOW CHART

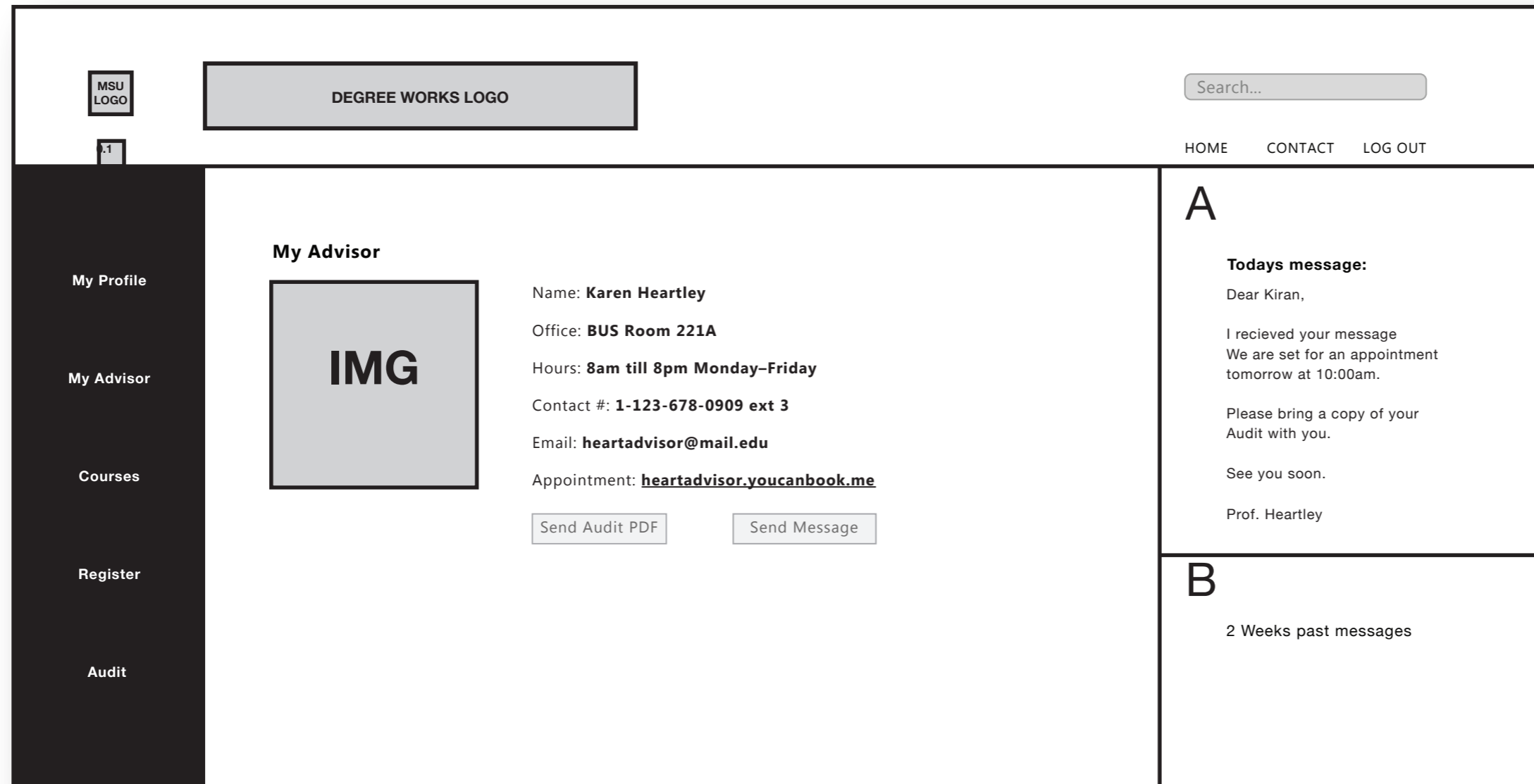

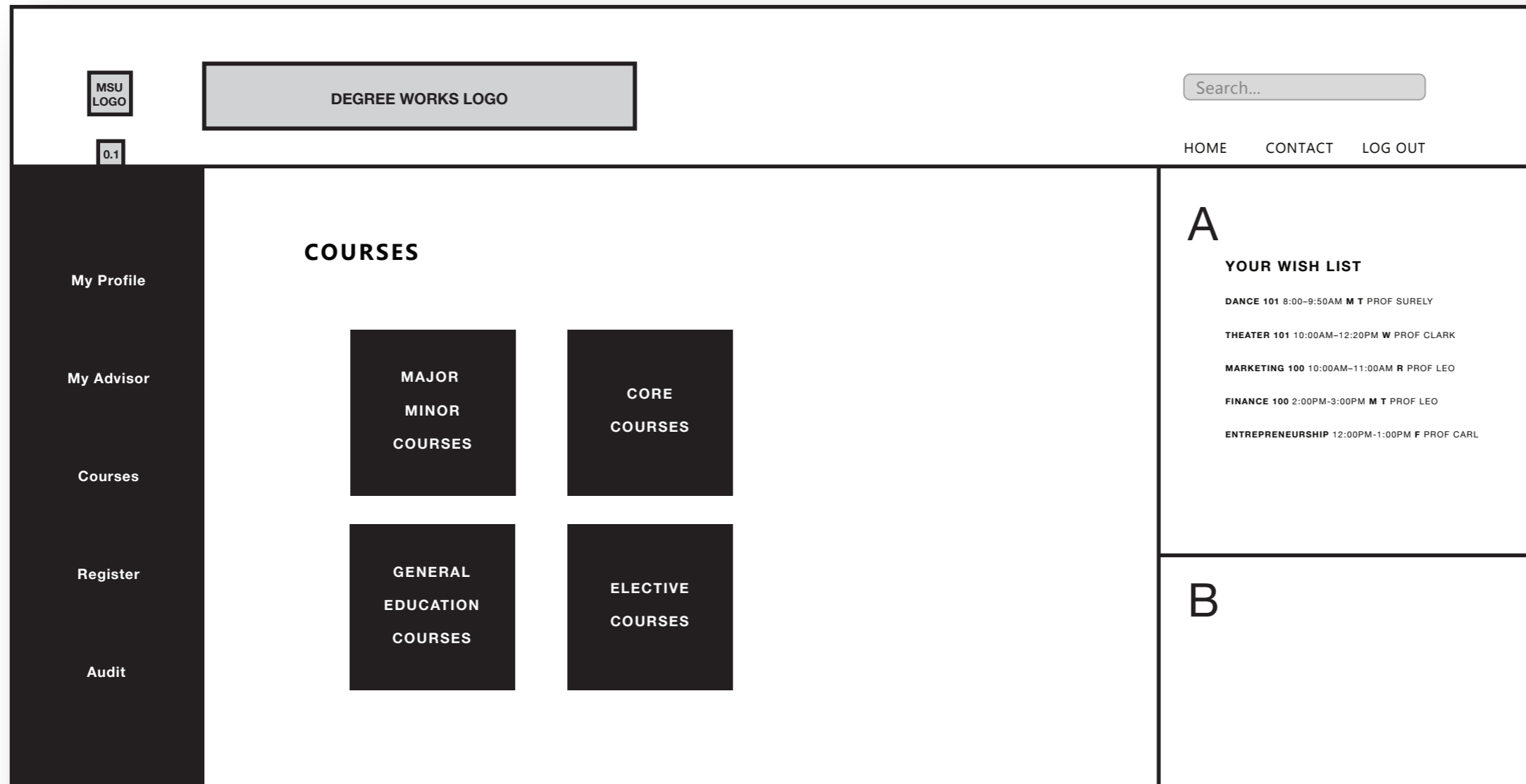

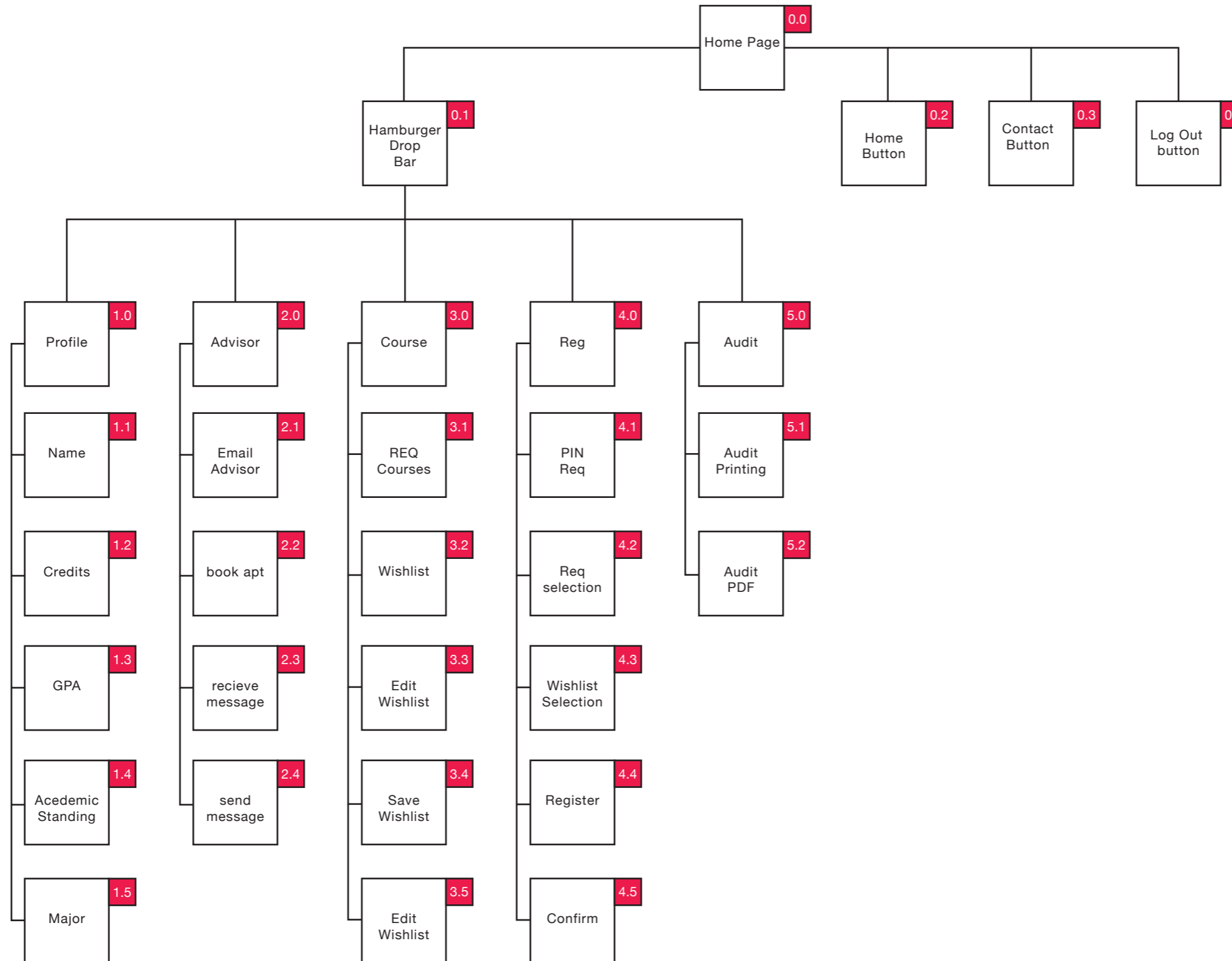
